In July 2005, Sophie along with 2,000 other organ transplant athletes competed in the XV World Transplant Games in London Canada.

This amazing woman bought home a tally of 6 medals in Rowing and Swimming (5 Gold and 1 Silver), breaking the World Record in the 100m Backstroke and setting the Rowing World Record.
